- carry out the separate collection of waste in the company,
- promote effective workshops and training in order to decrease accidents, near-misses and occupational diseases,
- guarantee prompt reaction to internal and external emergencies,
- set, implement, and maintain its objectives and targets in a continual-improvement approach.

In order to pursue these targets, according to the provisions of the Group Ethical Code, Italfond S.p.A has established an Integrated Management System for Quality, Environment, Health and Safety in the workplace, based on UNI EN ISO 9001:2015, UNI EN 9100:2018, UNI ISO 19443:2019, UNI EN ISO 14001:2015, and UNI EN ISO 45001:2023.

For the assessment of the environmental performances, Italfond S.p.A. considers the life-cycle perspective a useful tool to set its own policies. The impact of our product is monitored and analysed along its entire life cycle, from manufacturing to disposal.

To implement the Integrated Management System Policy, the Top Management has had a determining role in:

- analysing the economic and social business context,
- identifying the risks and the opportunities to pursue,
- · identifying the stockholders' needs,
- assessing environmental impact prior to any new production process or amendment,
- defining and monitoring the processes necessary to the Integrated Management System,
- carrying out activities fully complying with the stated or implied customer needs and with the product requirements,
- assessing the production plants environmental impact to take prevention and reduction actions,
- assessing the impact on workers' health and safety in order to take prevention and reduction actions,
- managing merit-based personnel in compliance with the principle of equal opportunities for all stakeholders, hiring with regular employment contracts and avoiding any form of discrimination against staff members,
- setting the economic objectives to achieve,
- making available the resources necessary to implement the Integrated Management System,
- defining the methods to measure/verify the effectiveness of the Integrated Management System,
- promoting a process of continuous improvement of the Integrated Management System,
- providing for a periodic review of this policy, included in the Management Review, to confirm it is compliant and up to date, verifying all processes and adapting them, where necessary, to achieve the set goals,
- assessing all aspects and risks associated with climate change as regards the development, the maintenance, and the effectiveness of management systems,
- guaranteeing adequate environmental training to all staff to ensure the commitment to the environment protection,
- preventing pollution and minimising the environmental risks related to the activity of Italfond S.p.A. by prior assessment and constant monitoring of both legal and voluntarily analysed parameters, as referred to in the Sustainability Report of the GIVA Group,
- monitoring, optimising, and reducing the consumption of resources, materials, and fuels aiming at saving energy, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and/or decreasing the use of fossil fuels,
- minimising the impact of material waste by reducing, recovering, and recycling it, as far as
